“No Paper/No Podium” Policy: By submitting an abstract, a potential presenter agrees to 1) submit a manuscript by September 1 for publication in the conference proceedings, 2) submit a PowerPoint presentation by October 1, and 3) register for the conference.

Dates: The conference will be held on November 15-16, 2010. Tours of local water reuse and desalination facilities will be conducted on Wednesday, November 17.

Location: The Water Reuse and Desalination conference will be held at Dockside, a purpose built convention centre located in Darling Harbour in Sydney, Australia. Dockside is only steps away from the harbour, fabulous restaurants, museums, an aquarium, and dozens of shops.
